GENERAL PRICE LIST

These prices are effective as of May 15, 2026, but are subject to change without notice.

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Funeral costs generally are divided into three areas: the services the funeral home provides, things you may purchase from a funeral home (merchandise), and things you may ask the funeral home to pay on your behalf (cash advances). This General Price List outlines those three areas. There is a lot of information here; ask your funeral professional if you have any questions.

Itemized service pricing begins on page 4. For simplicity sake, we have created packages of commonly selected options as follows:

Cremation Option Packages

If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are made of heavy cardboard or bamboo. Direct Cremation packages range in price from \$1845 to \$7680.

You will also select from options for what the body is placed in before and after cremations.

Alternative Containers range in price from \$145 to \$1295.

If you wish to select individual items you may do so from the list of Services the Funeral Home Provides on pages 4 and 5.

Gathering and Celebration followed by Cremation includes services associated with having the body present for a visitation and funeral service with cremation following the service.

2. DIRECT CREMATION DETAILED ARRANGEMENTS \$ 5575

Direct Cremation includes full services of staff with final disposition of the body by cremation. It allows a chance for positive identification at the funeral home or a limited chance to say goodbye by immediate family. [It provides all of the services included in Option 1 as well as:](#)

- ✓ Arrangement Conference by appointment with a funeral director
- ✓ Assistance writing an obituary and placement on our web site

1. DIRECT ONLINE SIMPLE CREMATION \$ 1990

Direct Cremation includes limited basic staff services to assist with final disposition of the body by cremation. This option includes an Alternative Container made of cardboard (\$145):

- ✓ Transfer from a Black Hawk County hospital or Care Center.
 - ✓ Arrangements online including for vital statistic information, authorizations from authorizing agent, and payment. Assistance and answers to questions are also available by phone.
 - ✓ Obtain required authorizations and Iowa Medical Examiner permit.
 - ✓ Prepare and file necessary certificates in Iowa.
 - ✓ Refrigeration and Cremation.
 - ✓ Positive Identification at the place of death or by an authorizing agent by photo.
 - ✓ We will place an obituary and photo you write, with our approval, on funeral home web site.
- This option **does not** include Viewing or Care of the Body when there is no embalming but with viewing.

This package includes all of the options above with the exception of a period of visitation the day before the service. It includes:

3. **TRIBUTE PACKAGE** **\$ 8250**

This package includes a weekday service before 2:00 and a casket. It is a savings of \$905.

However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

Services of Staff

Our fee for the services of funeral professional and staff includes, but is not limited to, staff to respond to initial request for service; arrangement conference with family or responsible party; preparation and filing of necessary authorization, certificates, and permits; and preparation of obituary notices. Also included in this charge are overhead expenses relative to our facility such as insurance, maintenance and utility expenses, and secretarial and administrative costs.

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.)

F. Cash Advances

This price list does not include costs for certain items which you may ask us to buy for you, such as honorariums for people who have a part in a service like a minister or musician, flowers, newspaper notices, hairdressers, certified copies of the death certificate, or cemetery expenses. The prices for those items will be shown on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected. We may advance these funds as a convenience to the family and make no charge for this service.

H. Specific Services

2. Immediate Burial

Includes services of staff, transfer to the funeral home from Black Hawk County, care of the body when there is no embalming, and transport to a local cemetery.

It **does not** include casket, embalming, or facilities and staff for viewing or ceremony.

a. Immediate Burial with casket provided by purchaser. \$ 5915

3. Celebration of Life Visitation \$ 4630

This package includes services of staff associated with arrangement facilities, and presence at a visitation. It does not include care of the body.

4. Celebration of Life Service \$ 5075

This package includes services of staff associated with arrangement and presence at a Memorial Service. It does not include care of the body.

5. Forwarding Remains to Another Funeral Home \$ 3975

Includes services of staff; transfer to funeral home from Black Hawk County; embalming; and shipping container. It **does not** include use of facilities or staff for viewing or transportation to non-local airport.

7. Receiving Remains From Another Funeral Home \$ 3895

Includes service of staff and transportation to a local cemetery. It **does not** include facilities or staff for viewing or ceremonies or transportation from a non-local airport.

9. Donation for Medical Science

a. Direct Donation \$ 5190

Includes limited services of staff, transfer to funeral home from Black Hawk County, and transportation to Iowa City.

It **does not** include viewing, visitation or memorial services.

b. Direct Donation with Memorial Service \$ 6195

Includes services of staff, transfer to the funeral home from Black Hawk County, memorial services, and transportation to Iowa City.

It **does not** include viewing or visitation.

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Covering the Cost of Funeral Expenses

Many people plan ahead for their last rites and the costs associated with them. Financially, their plans may include a prepaid funeral plan, life insurance, savings or investments. For others death comes unexpected and without the opportunity to plan or prepare.

It is important to be realistic about funeral expenditures. We do not want anyone to spend more than they are able to pay. It is our desire to offer affordable options to everyone, regardless of their situation.

As in all other transactions you are involved in, payment for our services, merchandise, and advance payments to others on your behalf is due at the time arrangement for the services are made. We know this can present an unneeded burden at a difficult time. Please visit with us about any special circumstances which you face.

We will openly and honestly discuss costs associated with our services, costs of merchandise, and costs of other arrangements. We will discuss with you the options we have for payment of these costs.

Consider the Pros and Cons of Each Payment Method

With any option that you choose, you must weigh the risks and benefits of each. On one end of the spectrum, you have fully-insured prepaid funeral plans. These plans offer the highest amount of protection. On the other end of the spectrum, you have personal accounts. These offer the least amount of protection for funeral funds. In the end, it's up to you to decide which option is the best for you and your family.

- Pre-funded funeral arrangements
- Cash Transaction. We accept Cash, Check, Cashier's Check or Money Order
- Credit Card payment. We accept Visa, MasterCard, Discover and American Express or a combination thereof
- Assignment of verifiable life insurance. The vendor we use for processing an Assignment charges a fee of 3.9% of the Assignment amount.

After the Services

Out of commitment for service, we offer our **Continuous Care program** to listen, care, educate, and provide you with support in difficult times. It is a free support service provided by the funeral home for the weeks and months to come. A Continuous Care Coordinator can help by providing support and resources for individuals and families after loss.
